This policy is effective January 1st, 2025.

Definitions

For the purposes of this privacy policy, the following definitions apply:

PII – Personally Identifiable Information

As described by United States Privacy Law

Information which can be used to distinguish or trace an individual's identity, such as their name, social security number, biometric records, etc. alone, or when combined with other personal or identifying information which is linked or linkable to a specific individual, such as date and place of birth, mother's maiden name, etc.

As described by the European Union General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

'personal data' means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ('data subject'); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person

Data Collection and Use

What data is collected and when is it collected?

When accessing our website, we may collect your:

Internet Protocol (IP) address, approximate location (IP-based), web pages requested, referring web page, browser used, date and time accessed, type of device, operating system, internet service provider, age, gender, ad-related interests, and other usage data

When submitting an inquiry on our website, we may collect your:

Full name, company, job title, e-mail address, telephone number, any additional information voluntarily submitted through the body of the inquiry

When ordering a product, we may collect your:

Shipping address, name and contact information of the person receiving the shipment, and any additional delivery information required to fulfil our contract with you

When contacting us directly:

When you email us or respond to our emails, we collect your email address, name, and any other information you choose to include in the body of your email or response.

When you contact us by phone, we may collect the phone number that you used to call us, and any other information you choose to convey through the conversation.

How do we use the information?

All the information PipeSak® collects is intended solely for enhancing your experience as our customer. Specifically, we may use the information for:

Enhancing site features, administrating contests/promotions/surveys, sending periodic e-mails regarding your order or other PipeSak® products and services, sending periodic newsletters, sending our "Project List for Quotation" inquiry e-mails, to directly contact you in response to an inquiry, and for the completion of our contract with you

Whenever possible, the data that is captured by our analytics is stripped of personally identifiable information and aggregated before being reviewed.

Do we share or sell the information we receive?

We do not sell customer information.

However, we work closely with our marketing partner and in some cases, we may share information with them for the sole purpose of enhancing your experience as our customer, as outlined above in the "How do we use the information?" section of this policy. We require our marketing partner to adhere to this policy.

We may share your information with our affiliates or business partners, in which case we will require those affiliates and partners to honor this policy. Affiliates include any subsidiaries, joint venture partners, or other companies that we control or that are under common control with us.

Certain information is automatically shared with our website hosting partner and other parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or serving our users. These parties are under obligation to keep this information confidential in adherence with this policy.

To complete our contract with you, we may need to share information with other third-party organizations. For example, we may share your shipping address with our freight provider so that they can deliver your order.

Under certain circumstances, we may be required to disclose the information we have collected in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g. in response to a lawful court order).

How do we protect your information?

At PipeSak® we take data protection seriously and make every available effort to ensure that the information and data that we have is not inappropriately accessed, disclosed, copied, modified, or otherwise compromised.

Any information that we collect is contained behind a secure network, and only accessible by a limited number of people who have explicit access rights. Only authorized PipeSak® employees are granted access rights. Anyone with access is required to keep all information confidential in adherence with this policy.

How long do we retain information?

We retain information for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this policy, and to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

Analytics Information

We use third-party analytics tools to help us measure traffic and usage trends. We use this information in conjunction with analytics information from other users so that it cannot reasonably be used to identify any individual user.
